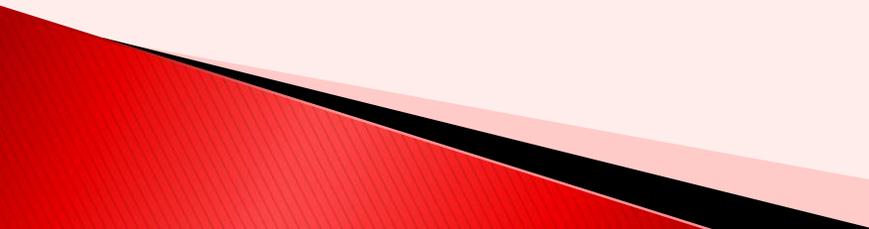

# Preamble

- ▶ **CSSPS is an abbreviation for Computerised School Selection and Placement System**
  - ▶ **It is a system used by the Ghana Education Service (G.E.S) to place students transiting from the Junior High Schools (JHS) into Senior High Schools(SHS), Senior High Technical Schools (SHTS) and Technical/Vocational Institutes (TVIs).**
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# Rationale for the 2020 Update

- ▶ Making available, detailed Tech/Voc. Programmes offered in each of the Senior High/Tech Schools in Ghana
  - ▶ Categorization of Purely Tech/Voc. Institutes
  - ▶ Introducing the new Policy ***One Compulsory Tech/Voc. Programmes*** for every candidate
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# Policy Guidelines (2020)

- ▶ **I. Public Second Cycle Institutions: Four groups namely Categories A, B, C and D**
- ▶ **II. Category E comprises of all 2nd cycle schools that offer Technical/Vocational Programmes**
- ▶ **II. Private Schools: Senior High Schools & Technical Vocational Institutions (Categories F & G) respectively**

# Policy Guidelines

## Updates Added

- ▶ **All Technical/ Vocational Institutions have been categorized into A, B and C, and added to SHS/ SHTS**
- ▶ **Category E comprises of all 2nd cycle schools that offer Technical/Vocational Programmes**
- ▶ **Appendix A; contains detailed Technical/ Vocational programmes**
- ▶ **Appendix B; contains detailed Senior High/Technical programmes**

# Policy Guidelines(Cont.)

# Policy Guidelines(Cont.)

- Six (6) Subjects are used for Selection & Placement (*Four core + Two Best*) These are:
  - i. English, ICT
  - ii. Mathematics, French
  - iii. Integrated Science BDT
  - iv. Social Studies RME  
Gh. Lang
- Aggregate & Raw scores of candidates are used.
- Choice of schools across regions allowed.

# Policy Guidelines(Cont.)

## CATEGORIES OF CANDIDATES

Categories of candidates processed for placement this year will include:

- **Category 1 : 2021 BECE candidates (Regular Candidates)**
- **Category 2 : 2021 Private BECE Candidates (Private Candidates.)**
- **Category 3 : Foreign Students (Foreign Candidates)**

# Policy Guidelines(Cont.)

## Selection Criteria

### Candidates :

1. **Must Choose five(5) schools**
2. **Must Select Programme and Accommodation for each choice**
- c. **Must List choices 1- 3 in order of preference**
- d. **Must Select their fourth (4th) choice school from Category E**
- e. **Must Choose their fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) choice school from Category D**
- f. **May select three(3) choices from Category C, One(1) from Category E and one(1) from category D**

## Selection Criteria (cont'd)

- g. Cannot select more than two (2) schools from Category B
- h. Cannot choose more than one (1) School from Category A
- i. Candidates who desire to pursue purely Technical Programme may select all 1st - 4th Schools from Technical/ Vocational Category (*and must still select the 5th Choice from Category D*)
  - PRIVATE SHS and PRIVATE TVET SCHOOLS are not BENEFICIARIES of FREE SHS.

Candidates who desire to pursue courses in private schools should make their own arrangements with those(private) schools.

# Selection Criteria(cont.)

- Candidates can select **1st - 5th** choice schools from a combination of **Categories A, B, and C.**
- List choices 1-3 in order of preference
- Must Select one (1) School and Programme (Tech/Voc.) from category **E as the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Choice (compulsory)**
- Choice five(5) must be candidates' Catchment Area Day school (**compulsory**)

# Selection Criteria(cont.)

# Selection Criteria(cont.)

## Examples of Wrong Selection Patterns

# POLICY GUIDELINES (Placement Procedure)

- Placement is by Merit.
- School and Programme options are linked
- In the event of a tie, candidates' raw scores are compared to help discriminate further.
- Candidates who slip out of all five choices can access schools using the **Self Placement Module**

# How The System Works (cont.)

## Self placement Module

Candidates who are not placed after auto placement (Unplaced Candidates) can use the **Self Placement Module** to place themselves.

### How It Works:

Candidates visit the CSSPS portal

[www.cssps.gov.gh](http://www.cssps.gov.gh) or [www.cssps.org](http://www.cssps.org)

Enter their details (*Index numbers & Pin codes*)

Schools with vacancies are made available for candidates to choose from.

Candidates print their placement form after submission.

# **30% Public JHS Allocation**

**30% of the total vacancies declared by each of the Category 'A' schools are reserved for candidates from the Public Basic Schools (JHS)**

**Implying that 30% of the total vacancies declared by all Category 'A' schools is reserved for Public Basic Schools (JHS) candidates who have selected that particular Category 'A' school**

# **30% Public JHS Allocation(Cont.)**

## **Who Qualifies?**

- **Strictly reserved for candidates of Public JHS**
- **To qualify for this, candidates are required to select a Category 'A' school**
- **It is automatic and not optional**
- **Public JHS candidates who choose Category 'A' schools compete for placement**

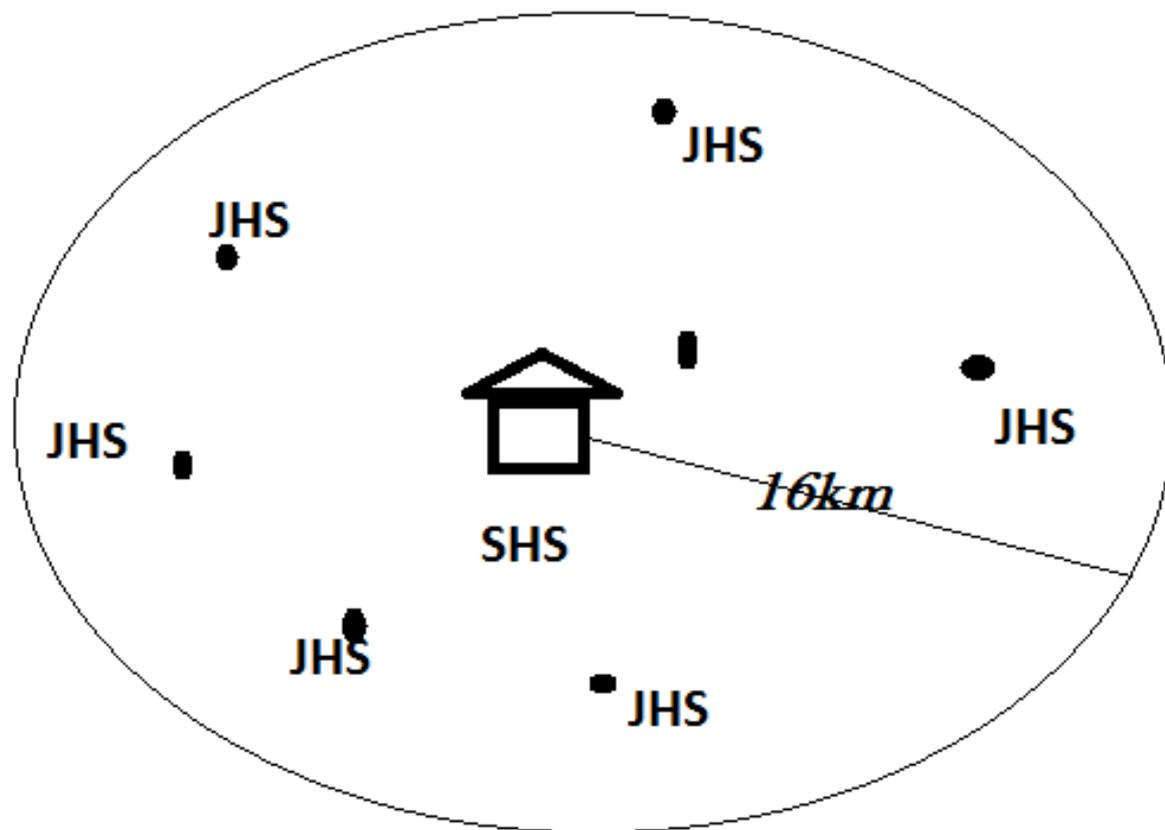
# **POLICY GUIDELINES**

## **Placement Procedure (Cont.)**

### **Catchment Area Day Schools(Category. D)**

- **These are Junior high Schools(JHS) located within a 10miles Radius (16km) of a Senior High School/Tech/Voc.**
- **Must be purely Day or Day/Boarding School/Tech/Voc.**
- **It could be one or more**
- **Could be located within different district/region**

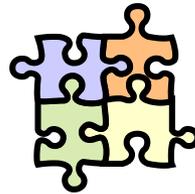
## Illustration of catchment area schools



## Tips for Candidates

- **Follow the right procedures in selecting the schools in each category.**
- **Make sure Schools code tally with schools' chosen.**
- **Assess your academic performance before making a choice**
- **Use Appendix 'B' as a guide to select a preferred Tech/Voc. programme (Category E)**
- **Never choose a day school outside your catchment area .**
- **Never let a café attendant select schools for you.**
- **Arrange your choices in order of priority (i.e 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> choices).**
