## THEORY

- Theory is a system of ideas intended to explain something.
- Theories are explanations of a natural or social behavior, event, or phenomenon.
- Depending on their intended use, variables may be classified as
  - independent,
  - dependent,
  - moderating,
  - mediating, or
  - control variables.

## SOCIAL NORMS THEORY

- Since the 1986 study in which Berkowitz and Perkins reported the misperceptions about alcohol consumption amongst <u>college</u> <u>students</u>, the use and study of the social norms approach has grown.
- 2. It has been used as a prevention technique for a variety of levels of prevention: universal, with large populations like entire college campuses; selective, with targeted subpopulations, and indicated, with individuals.

- 1. The first social norms <u>intervention</u> was implemented in 1989 by Michael Haines at <u>Northern Illinois University</u>, which targeted a universal campus population and over the years has shown significant success in terms of increasing healthy behaviors.
- This research at Northern Illinois University was done with a \$64,000 grant from the U.S.Department of Education Fund for the Improvement of Post Secondary Education (FIPSE).

- Many other universities have since followed suit and have had similar success in the reduction of high-risk drinking behaviors, such as <u>Hobart and William Smith Colleges</u>, the <u>University of</u> <u>Arizona</u>, and <u>University of North Carolina</u>, to name a few.
- Since these achievements have become well-known, the social norms approach has been used successfully to reduce smoking, <u>drinking and driving</u>, and <u>HIV</u> risk behaviors, and to increase <u>seat belt</u> use.

• It has also gained widespread use

targeting <u>adolescents</u> and <u>high school</u> students, and has been used in an attempt to reduce drinking and smoking behaviors amongst those populations.

• Recently, <u>interventions</u> have been tested to reduce sexual

assault, and the results were reported to be "promising".

#### **TYPES OF SOCIAL NORMS**

- Two types of norms are relevant to a social norms approach: *injunctive norms* and *descriptive norms*:
- . **Injunctive norms** reflect people's perceptions of what behaviors are approved or disapproved by others. They assist an individual in determining what is acceptable and unacceptable social behavior.
- . **Descriptive norms** involve perceptions of which behaviors are typically performed. They normally refer to the perception of others' behavior. These norms are based on observations of those around you.
